TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The exhibition is open to textile artists who live in regional Victoria.
- Works entered must have been made since 1 January 2008, to the artist's own design.
- Items can be made using any medium: fabric, fibre, wire, paper, threads, etc. and using any techniques: stitching, weaving, basketry, knitting, felting, dyeing, etc.
- Several techniques or types of materials may be used.
- Exhibitors may submit up to three entries.
- An entry fee of \$15.00 will be charged to each exhibitor (please note one fee covers all your entries).
- A **Statement of Intent** should be completed and returned to Judith Roberts, 10 Fairmaid Rd, Kialla Central 3631, or judith@mcmedia.com.au by Friday, 20 November 2009.
- An entry form for each work and a cheque, made payable to Shepparton Arts Alliance Inc., for the \$15.00 exhibitor's fee, should be returned to Judith Roberts, 10 Fairmaid Rd, Kialla Central 3631 by Friday, 15 January 2010.
- All entries must be delivered to the Eastbank Centre, Welsford Street, Shepparton, on Tuesday, 2 March 2010 between 10.00am and 4.00pm.
- All unsold entries must be collected on Monday, 15 March 2010 from the Eastbank Centre between 10.00am and 12.00 noon.
- It is the responsibility of exhibitors to insure their work.
- Works may be offered for sale with a commission of 20% payable to Eastbank Centre.
- Works to be hung must be delivered with appropriate fittings (including rod) for hanging.
- Each work must be labelled with the artist's name, title of work and "Inspired to Create" on the back lower right hand corner where possible.
- All works must be delivered and collected free of charges.
- Not all entries may be displayed, as the exhibition is subject to curatorial discretion and no discussion will be entered into regarding the selection of works.

All exhibitors will receive an invitation to the opening.

Assistance with supervising the exhibition during the hours of opening would be appreciated.
